The Preschool Communication Clinic at The University of Melbourne is a student-run, expert-led clinical service for children aged 2½ to 5 years of age, who have speech or language difficulties

Who is the clinic for?

The clinic is for children between two and a half years and five years of age who have difficulty in at least one of the following areas:

- understanding spoken language
- using words or sentences to express themselves
- speaking clearly so that others can understand them

How is the clinic run?

Children will have a comprehensive assessment and you will be provided with a written report. Therapy sessions will be tailored to specific goals identified in conjunction with parents.

Student speech pathologists are supported by an expert clinician throughout the appointment.

Clinic days

The clinic is run once weekly on a Monday or Tuesday.

Fees

Initial appointment: \$90

Subsequent appointments: \$60

Payment must be made on the day of the appointment.
