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Preparing for your MMI

Technical Requirements

Technical/Equipment Requirements

To prepare for your MMI, you should check that your equipment meets the following requirements.

Minimum Requirements:

Laptop or Computer

Connected Webcam (video)

Connected or Integrated Microphone (audio)

Stable Internet Connection (see [here](#) for more information)

Recommendations:

Wired headset for audio. We do not recommend Bluetooth headsets as they can disconnect during your interview without you knowing.

Browser Compatibility:

Google Chrome 63+ (recommended)

Edge 79+

Mozilla Firefox 50+

Safari 14.0.2+ (for Mac only)

Interview Recording Setup

The example of an ideal interview setup for your MMI:

1. Clear lighting, not backlit.
2. Connected webcam with
3. you centred in the image.
4. Light, neutral background.
5. Wired headset for clear audio.





Preparing for your MMI

Internet Requirements

It's most important to ensure a strong, stable internet connection for your MMI. Please use the following guidelines to check your connection and setup.

To ensure a seamless experience during your MMI we recommend a download speed of 20Mbps and upload speed of 1Mbps. You can use [this tool to test your internet connection speed](#).

Wired Internet Connection:

If you are able to connect directly to your router via an ethernet cable this will give you better reliability and more consistent speed. [Here is a useful guide for connecting to your router via a wired connection](#).

Wireless WiFi Connection:

If you only have WiFi available to you, we recommend that you minimise competition for bandwidth on your connection. If you are in a house or on a network with other people:

- Request that they do not stream during your MMI (ie Netflix etc)
- Request that they are not gaming on your network during your MMI

Tethering to a Mobile Device

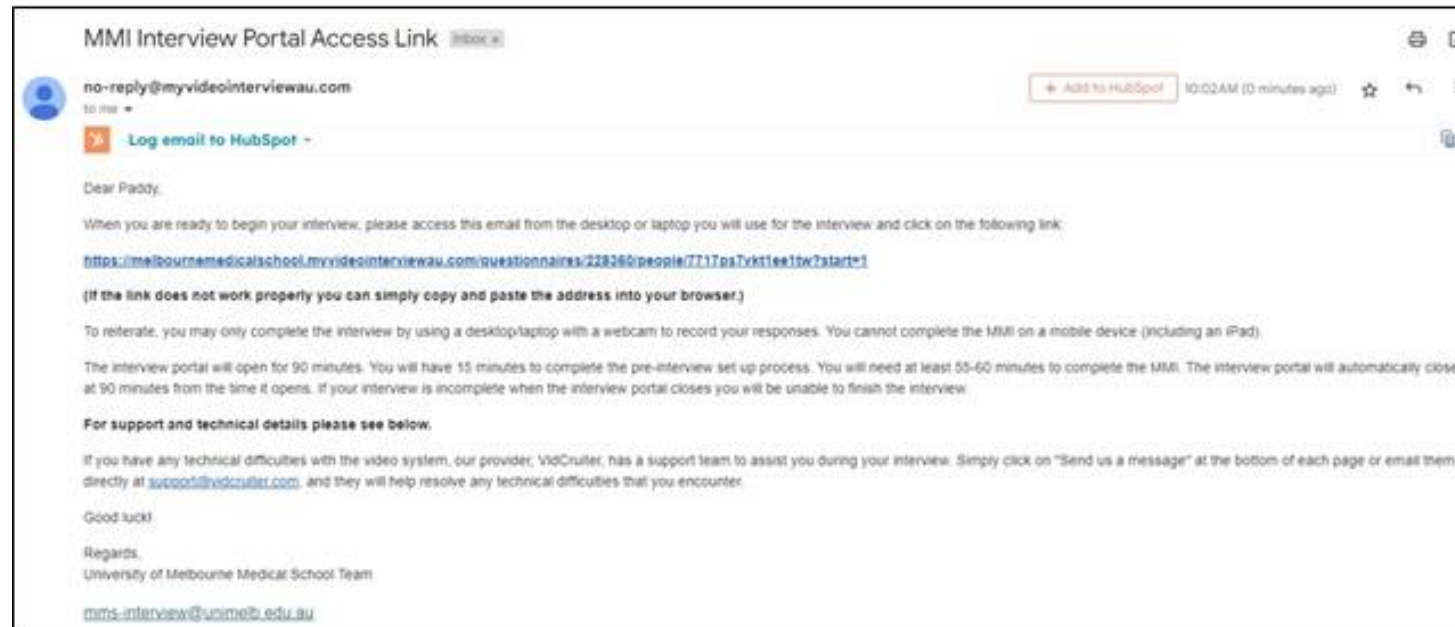
Unless you have no other option, we would not recommend tethering to a mobile device. Although you can get good connection speeds, it is less stable and reliable than wired or WiFi connections.



Starting your MMI

Accessing the MMI Portal

Fifteen minutes before your scheduled MMI time you will receive an email like the one below inviting you to access the MMI portal to begin your preparation. This fifteen minute window will give you time to review the instructions and assessment conditions, test your equipment and complete your ID and room verification. We recommend that you begin as soon as you receive this email to ensure you are ready to go at your scheduled MMI time.



Starting your MMI

Landing page

When you first open your MMI portal, you will navigate to the landing page. Take a moment to read the high-level instructions on this page, before proceeding to the equipment testing page.

Take particular note of the explanation of the countdown timers as these will be what drives the MMI format.

You will also get a chance to familiarise yourself with the virtual interview format by participating in the Mock MMI prior to the live MMI.

 - Before you begin, you will have the opportunity to run an equipment test to ensure you are comfortable with the recording process. Spend as much time as you need on this page to familiarise yourself with the equipment and instructions.

- MMI Information**
 - Overview**
 - The following interview process is comprised of six interview stations. **The MMI will take approximately 60-70 minutes.**
 - Each **Interview Station** includes an initial **Preparation Page** containing a scenario, followed by **four questions** (see image 1 below). As you move into each station the scenario and questions will automatically open. If the recorder does not automatically open as you enter the station, click the **"Open Recorder"** button on the question page (see image 2 below).
 - Between each station you will have a short break to collect yourself before moving to the next station.
 - Please note:** Once you start the MMI, you will not be able to stop or pause the timers on each page. You will need to complete the MMI in one sitting.

Image 1: The stem and questions will display for 40 seconds before your 5 minute answer time commences.

Equipment Testing Page

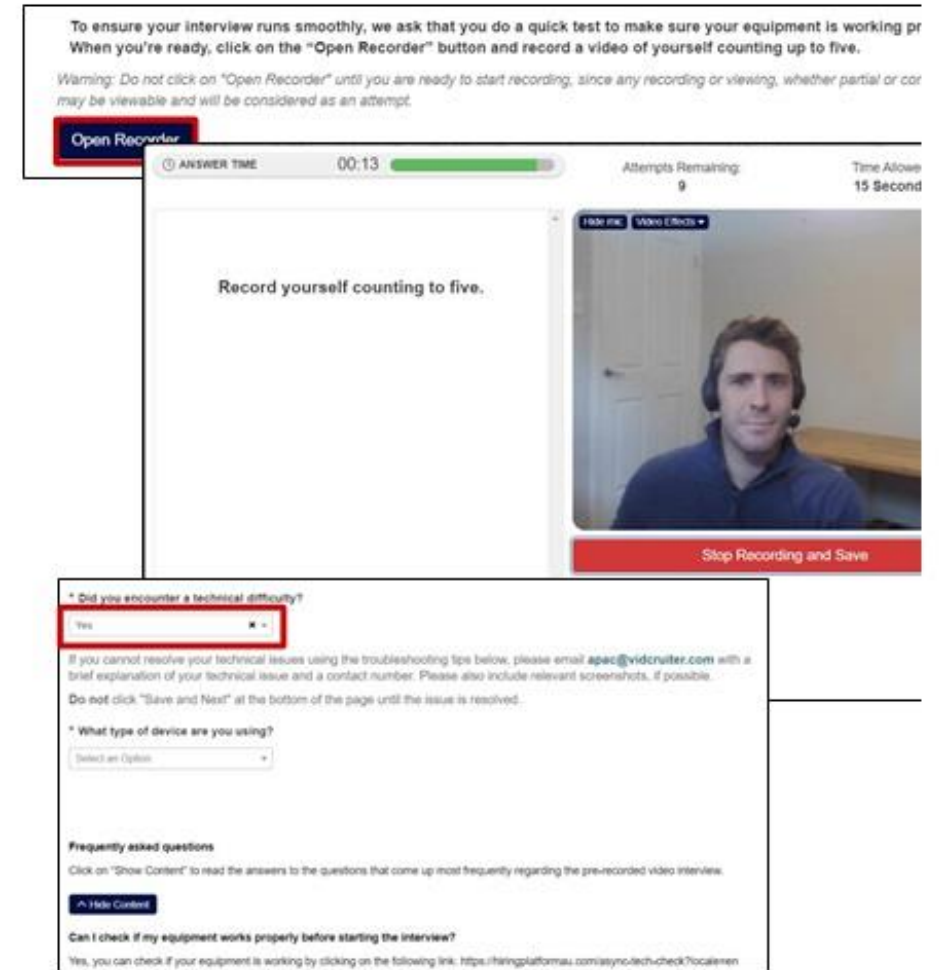
On this page, you will have the opportunity to open a video recording window to test your equipment before starting the actual MMI. This is exactly the same window in which you will record your responses to each station, so it's important to ensure that it operates correctly with your equipment set up on the day.

Importantly, you want to check:

1. Your video is displaying clearly
2. Your audio is being picked up sufficiently

Make sure you review your test recording after you finish to confirm both of the above. If you have any issues, you can refer to the provided troubleshooting information or click “Send us a message” at the bottom of the page.

Generally, if you experience any issues on this page, the simplest fix will be to open your MMI link in a different browser ([see browser compatibility](#)).

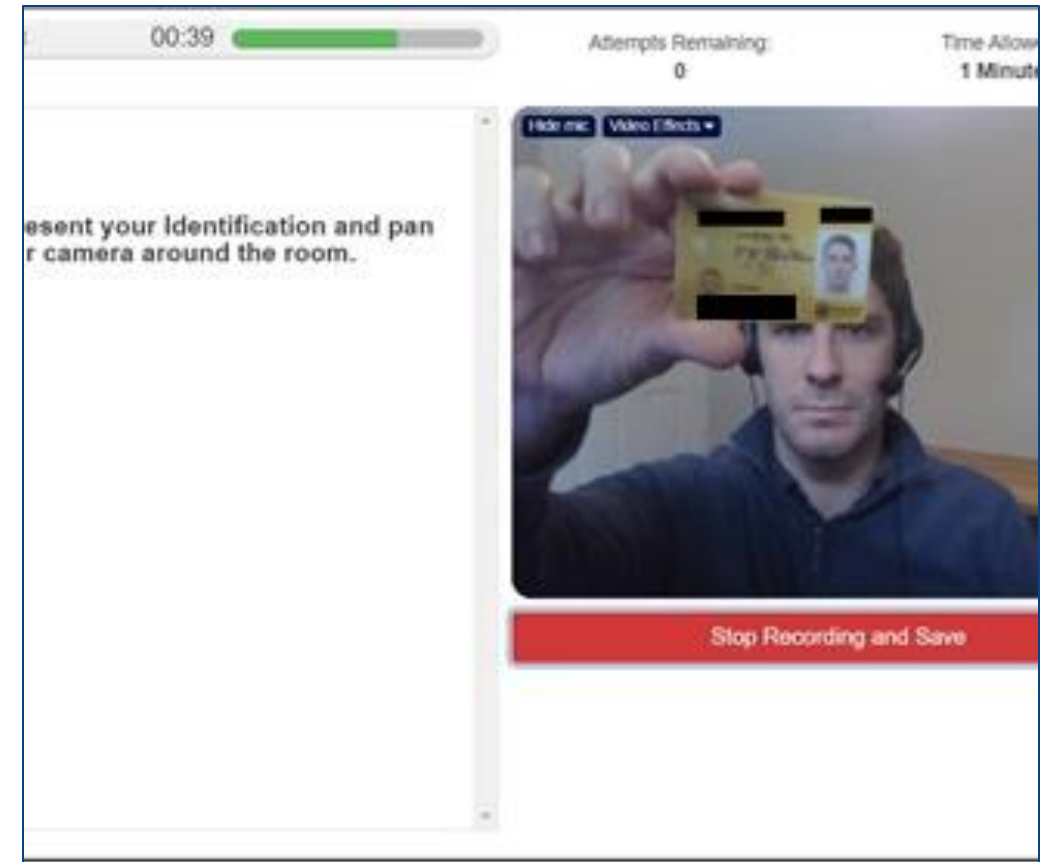

Verification of Room and ID

The final preparation step to complete prior to commencing your MMI is the Room and ID Verification.

To complete this, you will need to click “Open Recorder” on this page. Once your recording begins:

1. Present your photo ID clearly to your webcam.
2. Lift your laptop or connected webcam and pan around your room.

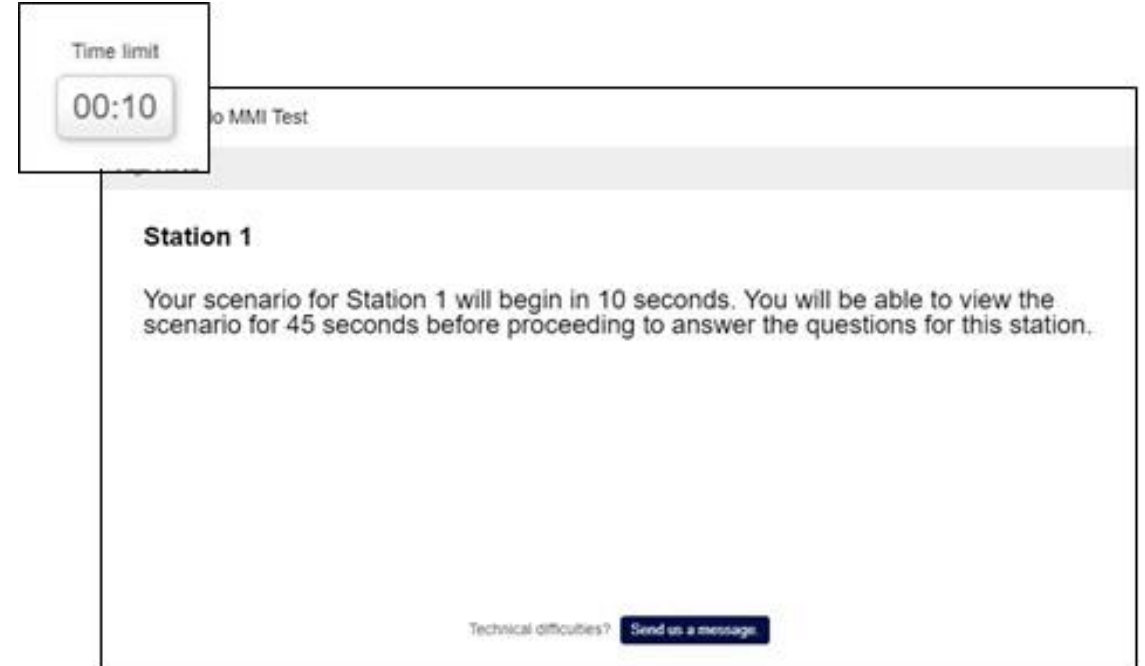
Station Instruction page

Before you are presented with your scenario or stem for each new station, you will land on an instruction page.

You will stay on this page for 10 seconds before proceeding to the scenario.

In particular, you should take note of the format of the scenario, so you know what to expect on the next page. The scenario will be in the format a body of text.

Once the 10 second timer on this page expires you will automatically proceed to the scenario page.





Completing your MMI

Scenario Page

Each station will contain a scenario which the four station questions will refer to. The scenario will be in the format a body of text.

You will have 45 seconds to review the scenario before you proceed to the station questions where you will begin your interview responses.

The scenarios will also be displayed to you along with the interview questions when you're recording your responses.

As soon as the 45 second timer expires, you will proceed to your first question for that station.

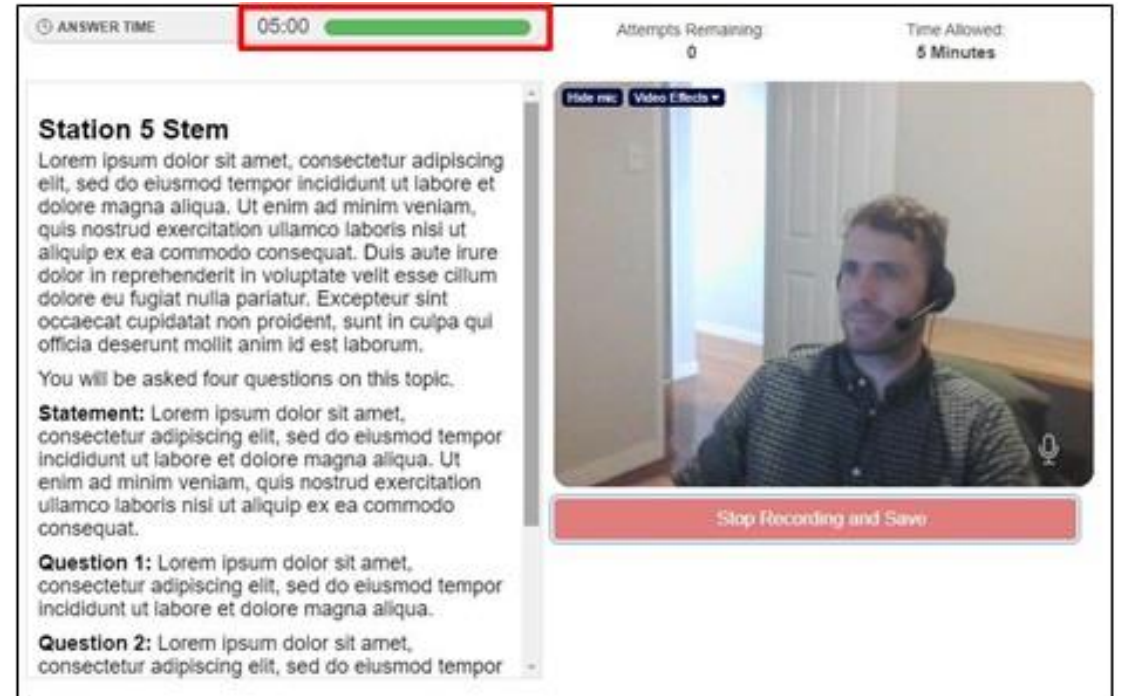

Completing your MMI Station Question Page

As soon as you enter each station question page, the recorder window will open up automatically and your first question will be displayed.

You will see a three second countdown before your recording starts.

Once your countdown finishes, the recording will start automatically, and you will have five minutes to record your responses to all questions in that station. It is your responsibility to manage your time, to ensure you can answer all questions in this allotted time. You will not be able to return to previous stations after you've moved on.

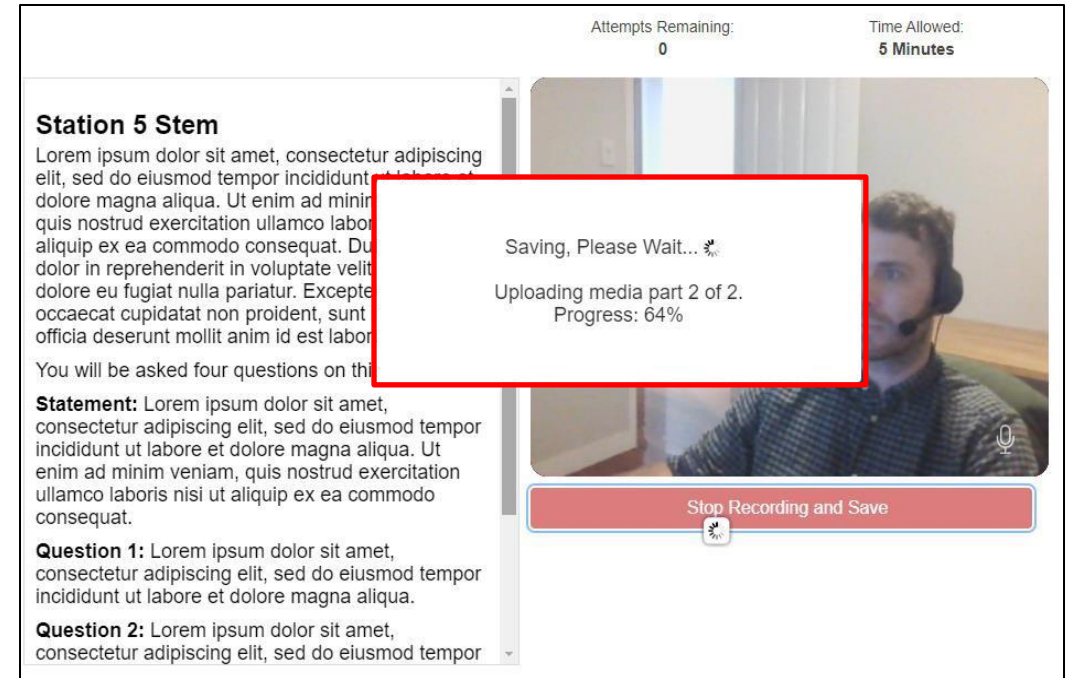

Station Question Page (cont.)

When your response time for each question expires, you will be moved automatically onto your next station.

It may take a moment to upload your response before the next question can load. In some instances, this may take up to a minute.

Please wait for this upload to complete, and **do not** attempt to refresh your browser. You will not be penalised for time if it takes longer to upload your responses for each station.

Technical issues

Technical issues while completing the MMI

If you experience any technical issues while recording your responses to a station, you might unintentionally be exited from the recording window. If the recording window is closed during a station you **will not** be able to re-enter that particular station during the MMI session.

If this occurs, click “Save and Next” at the bottom of the page to continue to the next station.

At the conclusion of the MMI, you can then report your issue via the link (see image). Your case will be reviewed, and you will be advised of next steps via email.
