

Speech Pathology Clinic Fee Schedule and Attendance Policy

Fee schedule: from January 2018

Childhood Communication Clinic for children aged 2.5-5 years of age with speech or language difficulties or children aged 5-8 years with speech sound disorders:

First session (assessment): \$100 (concession: \$60)

Subsequent sessions: \$70 (concession: \$40)

Childhood Apraxia of Speech clinic for children aged 3-12 years with Childhood Apraxia of Speech (diagnosed or suspected).

First session (assessment): \$100 (concession: \$60)

Subsequent sessions: \$70 (concession: \$40)

Stuttering clinic for children, adolescents and adults who stutter

First session (assessment): \$150 (concession: \$80)

Subsequent sessions: \$100 (concession: \$60)

Adult speech and language clinic for adults who have dysarthria or aphasia

Program fee: \$250 (concession: \$150)

(covers all sessions including assessment and treatment, paid in two instalments)

NB: Concession rates for our clinics are available for those with a valid Health Care Card.

Important: Private health insurance, Medicare (Chronic Disease Management) and NDIS

Due to requirements of Private Health insurers and Medicare regarding the way that services are provided, University of Melbourne Speech Pathology Clinic fees are **not** refundable through Medicare or Private health insurers. We also do not currently offer services through NDIS.

Attendance policy

We appreciate that you may need to change or cancel appointments for many reasons. We ask that notice is given to allow us to fill the appointment if we can. From January, 2018, fees will be charged for late notice cancellations or failure to attend a session without previous notification, as per below:

- Late cancellation (within 24 hours of session) – 50% of session fee
- Failure to attend session without notification – 100% of session fee
