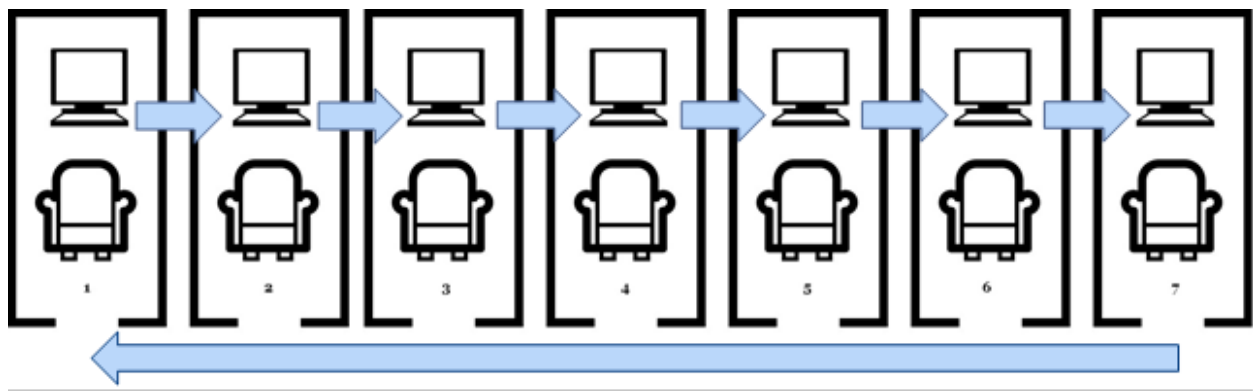

What is a MMI?

The MMI consists of eight separate interview stations with one interviewer at each. Each station takes five minutes to complete and comprises of several questions on the same topic. The duration of the whole interview process for each applicant is approximately 50 minutes. The MMI is designed to assess non-cognitive qualities including maturity; motivation; communication skills; ability to empathise and provide support; attitude to collaboration and decision making.

Interviewers will be assigned to their breakout room will start with their first interviewee. At the end of the 5 minutes, the interviewees will be moved along to their next breakout room where a new interviewer is waiting. The Interviewers will be directed on the day.



Who can be an interviewer?

Anyone can volunteer to be an interviewer provided they:

- Are fluent in English
- Believe that there is no likelihood of a person known to them (e.g. relative, friend, tutee, close acquaintance) seeking entry to Physiotherapy at the University of Melbourne in the next few years.
- Agree to a confidentiality and conflict of interest statement
- Are able to use a computer

MMI interviewer training dates and times

If you have never interviewed before, you will be required to attend/undertake training. These training sessions will take place via ZOOM on Tuesday 10 August and Wednesday 18 August. Interviewers will only need to attend one session.

If you undertook training in 2020, you will not be required to undertake additional training. A refresh document will be provided to you ahead of the MMI and we ask you review this information prior to the briefing session.

The MMI period will be from Tuesday 24 August – Wednesday 1 September.
We ask interviewers to be available for the entire duration of the session.
