RE: Clinic Audiology Kits and Oscopes

Throughout the Master of Clinical Audiology degree, you will participate in many practical sessions as well as clinical work. To ensure that all students have access to the same, high quality materials and equipment, you are required to purchase your own Clinical Audiology Kit. This kit is especially formulated for this course and is put together in such a way that you receive a significant discount on all equipment compared to if you were purchasing separately. This kit will last you well into your career.

A few important points about your kit:

1. **It is compulsory to acquire a Clinical Audiology Kit and otoscope.**
2. There are multiple options on the website depending on which otoscope you prefer or whether you will purchase an otoscope separately. All otoscopes on the Posita website are fit for purpose.
3. The Clinical Audiology Kit and otoscope (if purchasing through Posita) must be ordered and paid for by *Thursday 13th February 2020*. Clinical audiology kits ordered and paid for by Thursday 13th February are scheduled for delivery in the final week of February. Orders completed after the 13th February until the end of the month are scheduled for delivery during early March.
4. If you are purchasing your otoscope separately, you will need to have it by Monday 2nd of March.
5. Your Clinical Audiology Kits will be posted to your nominated address, if you wish you can have it delivered to the University at the following address: Please post to Frank Mount, Level 1, 550 Swanston St, Carlton 3053. This can be then picked up any time before your first Prac.
